#### ***Robert Stluka recognized for his service on the Williamson County Board of Health***

Mr. Robert Stluka, appointed to the Board of Health in August 2006 by the Williamson County Commissioners' Court, was recognized for his years of dedicated service to the Williamson County and Cities Health District (WCCHD) and the residents of Williamson County at the January 5, 2010 Board meeting. Mr. Stluka, who will soon be moving outside the county, announced he will be leaving his position on the Board.

Prior to his Board appointment Mr. Stluka served three years as mayor of the City of Round Rock and nine additional years as a city councilman. He previously served in various capacities within the Round Rock and Austin Chambers of Commerce and is a former Board member of the Round Rock Area Serving Center and Williamson County Children's Advocacy Center. Mr. Stluka is the current owner and chief consultant of Texas Government Consulting, Inc. a government relations and business development consulting firm.

Mr. Stluka has been a strong advocate of public health in Williamson County and through his actions has made a huge impact on WCCHD and the residents of Williamson County. His insight has contributed to the strong public health governance system and processes that remain almost unique to Williamson County while his credibility with outside stakeholders and governmental bodies has contributed greatly to the success of many critical public health endeavors.
