



Your Proline Aerobic Treatment Unit (ATU)

Recently, WCCHD was made aware that NSF International has removed Proline from their list of certified systems. At this time, WCCHD is awaiting TCEQ guidance regarding the repair parts options available to owners of these systems. Our goal is to provide owners with responses that are consistent with the intent of TCEQ and NSF.

Background Information:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) lists On-Site Sewage Facility (OSSF) products that are approved for use throughout Texas. TCEQ requires that aerobic treatment units are tested for certain performance standards before they are approved for use. The WCCHD licensing role is to review and inspect the treatment unit making sure that the treatment unit and components came from the State approved list.

There are several manufacturers of ATU systems, each with unique proprietary components. Each brand's products are tested with unique parts as a package to meet the performance standards. Thus, the use of substitute replacement parts provided by other manufacturers is not allowed.
